- i) The industry should provide necessary effluent treatment and disposal facilities as per the consent granted by Maharashtra Pollution Control Board.
- ii) Alkaline/urea scrubber will have to be provided after the water scrubber.
- iii) The industry should make provision for limiting the NOx emissions from the Oxalic Acid Plant.
- iv) The terms and conditions stipulated by the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board in its consent order should be strictly complied and inform the compliance of these conditions before commencement of production to Maharashtra Pollution Control Board.
- v) Tree plantation programme should be undertaken as indicated in the consent letter granted by Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, on the factory land, in consultation with the Forest Department of the State Government.
